creating a subreport to show additional information not available on the original report. Additionally, you will learn how to define custom groups that cannot be directly created from the fields in a table. You will then learn how to alter the appearance of the cross-tab to add formatting, repeat headers across multiple pages, and hide items that you don't want to see. Additionally, you will learn how to create alerts for a report. An alert will notify you if your report data meets the condition specified by the alert. You will also learn how to add dynamic text and formatting to a report based on whether an alert is triggered. Finally, you will learn how to create expandable drill-down reports that display data at a high level, while hiding the detailed data and showing it only when requested.
